Punta Cana weather in March High: 30°C Low: 21°C



Since it falls toward the end of the dry season, March sees very little rainfall with just 55mm divided between four rainy days. Punta Cana enjoys around nine hours of sunshine every day. The March skies are partly cloudy with a median cloud coverage of 46 per cent, which hardly changes throughout the month.



Airport

Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ) is a 25-minute drive from the Paradisus Palma Real Golf & Spa Resort. Offering direct flights from over 28 countries and 96 cities worldwide, this is the busiest airport in the Dominican Republic and the second busiest in the Caribbean region. You can easily organize your transfers from the airport to the hotel online with **Otium Tour.**

Interprefy mobile app user guide

Live English to French translation will be available for most sessions using Interprety. How to access real-time interpreting using the Interprety mobile app. Please connect your smartphone to a reliable WiFi network.

1 - Download and install the Interprefy app



2 – Plug in your earphones or headset, click «Ok».

3 – Enter the event token: CCA-ACC2024 and click «connect».

Enter the verification code that you have received via email or text message (SMS) and click «submit».

4 – If two-factor authentication is active:

Enter your registered email address or mobile phone number (format: +41 79 1234567) to receive a verification code.

5 – Select your preferred audio language.

When the session is finished, click «disconnect» to leave the session.

Settings — If «incoming auto-volume» is selected, original floor sound will be audible, when interpreter is silent.
